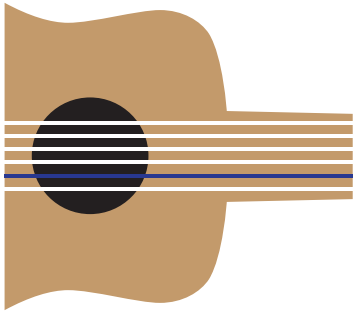


Learn How To Play Your Second String

Modern Guitar Approach



a few things to know about **Your Second String**

- it is second to the smallest string on your guitar
- it sounds the second highest
- it is the second closest string to the ground
- blue is the color used to represent the 2nd string.

PLAY *on your second string*

(1st finger, 1st fret) (2nd finger, 2nd fret)

0 0 0 0 1 1 1 1 0 0 0 0 2 2 2 2

(3rd finger, 3rd fret) (4th finger, 4th fret)

0 0 0 0 3 3 3 3 0 0 0 0 4 4 4 4

now try this:

0 1 2 3 4 4 3 2 1 0

one more:

0 0 1 1 3 3 0 3 2 1 3 2 1 0

Combining your **FIRST** and **SECOND** strings
(remember that **red** is the first string on your guitar)

Mary Had A Little Lamb

0 3 1 3 0 0 0 3 3 3 0 3 3
Ma-ry had a lit - tle lamb, lit - tle lamb, lit - tle lamb.

0 3 1 3 0 0 0 0 3 3 0 3 1
Ma-ry had a lit-tle lamb whose fleece was white as snow
